

We have the C Ray Wilson scholarship program that has been a valuable resource for the Students in the Tigard Tualatin school district. We usually have between 12-15 applicants for the \$500 scholarships. The applicants have shown us how very industrious, hardworking, and focused they are on their educational goals. Many of the applicants are in Advanced Placement classes, already receiving college credit. There are 5 Legion members who read and determine who the recipients

will be. These decisions are not easy and the applications accentuate the hard work these students have done and their many accomplishments. The applications will come in early May,



be read and then will be awarded at the Senior Honors night. We have been able to award scholarships to both Tigard High and Tualatin High in the past.

We have a second scholarship program this year so we can support our Boys State attendees who both did extremely well. You will see "Scholarship Bucks" for sale for \$5 being offered this year because the Legion wanted to honor these outstanding young men who did not meet qualifications for the C Ray Wilson scholarship. One of our attendees was selected to go to Boys Nation and many of you heard him speak at the Americanism dinner about his adventures and what he learned from this experience.
